- ArcGIS Online/MASS/MRP “hack-a-thon”
 - verify that states can access AGOL and can see all groups, folders, and content
 - verify that states can post to AGOL and subscribe to content
 - verify that states can access MASS, create MRP, change status & location of MRP
 - verify that states can subscribe to MRP rest service
