Issues Resolved

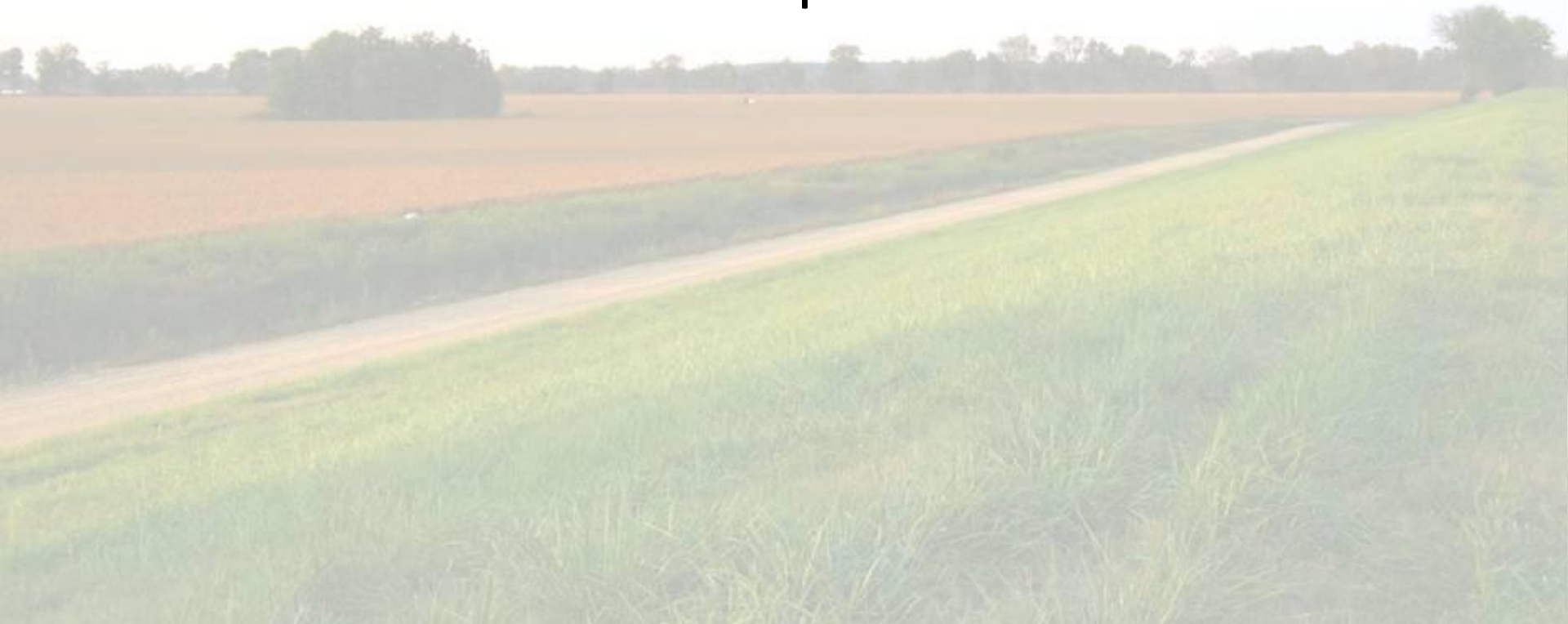
- Organic NG assets
