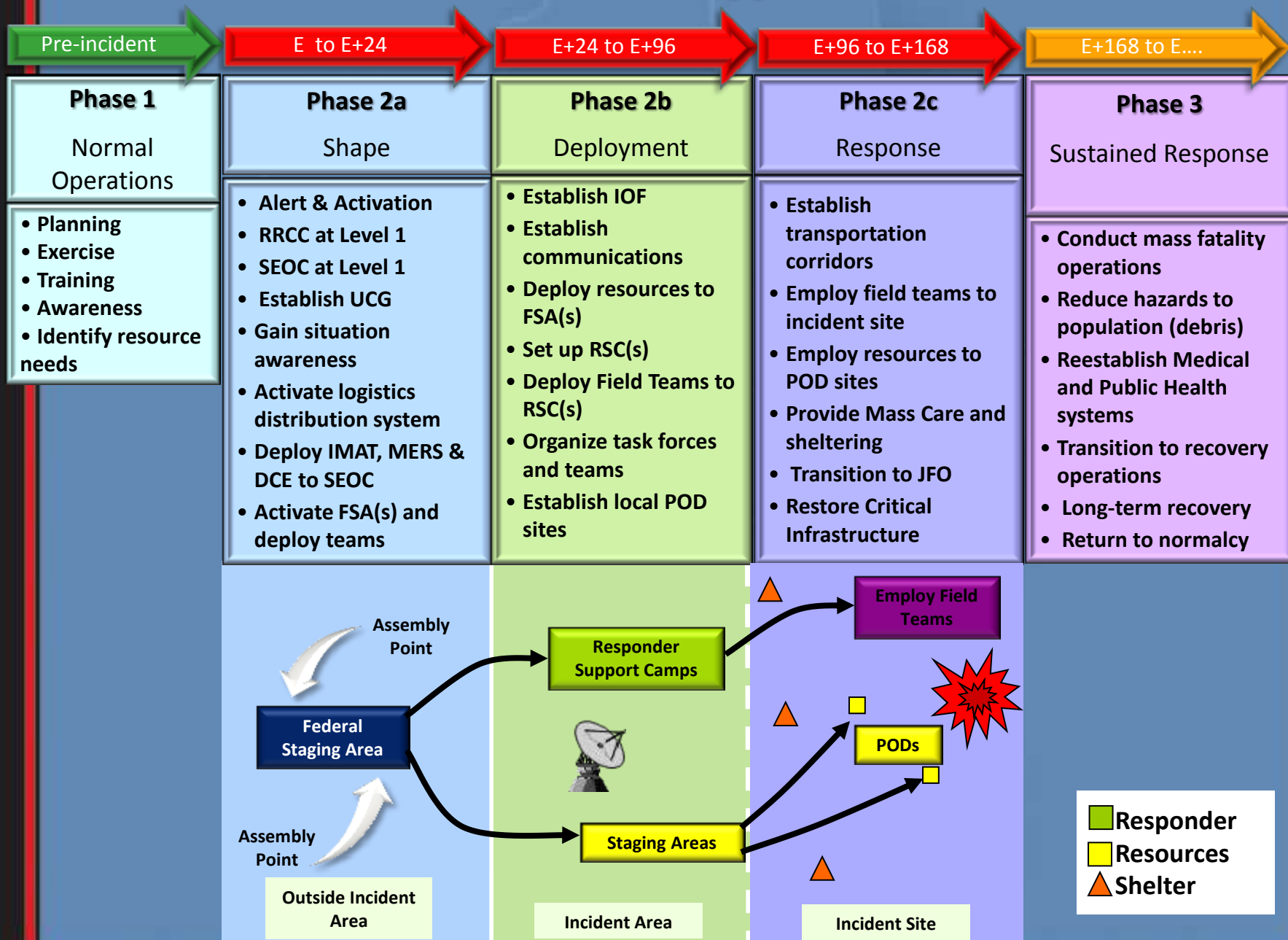

I+24 to I+72: Delivered to Staging Area

- 1,512,000L Water to Stuttgart
- 852,480 Meals to Stuttgart
- 8,400 Cots to Stuttgart
- 20,000 Blankets to Stuttgart

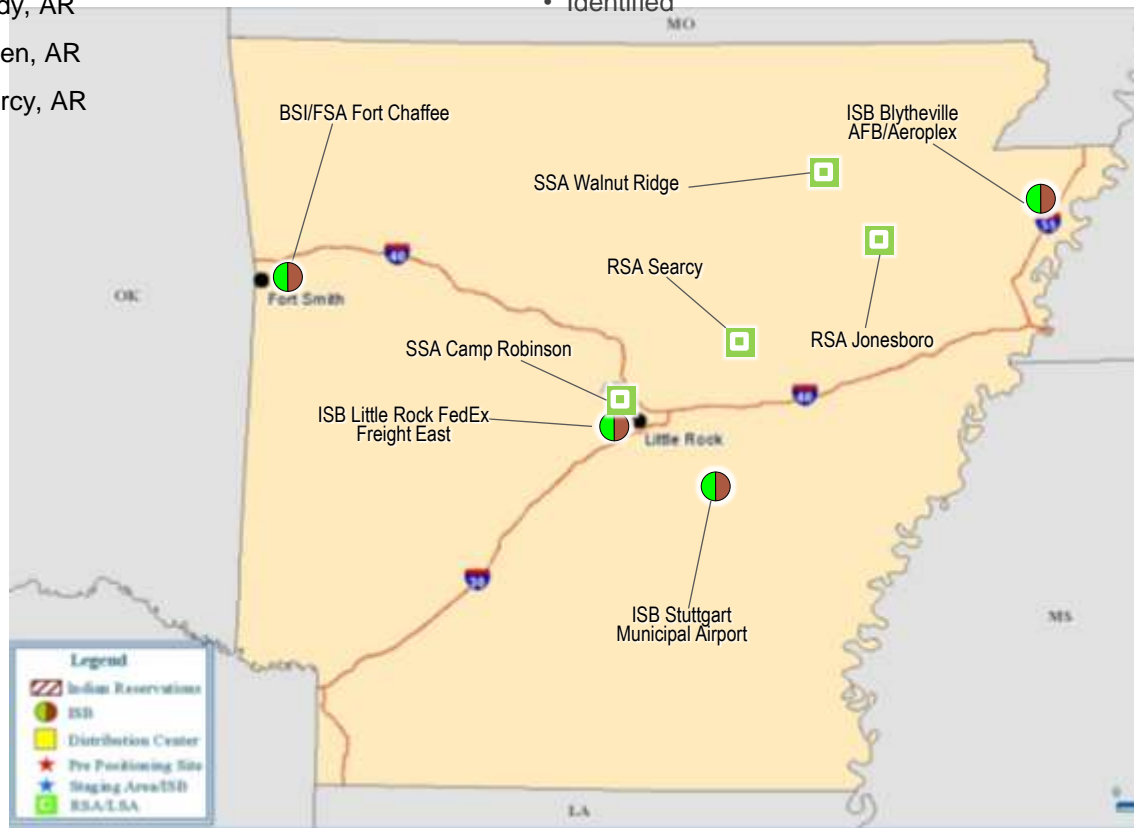
