

**CUSEC Private Sector Advisory Group Breakout Session**

**Purpose:** To continue to process to build consensus on working models for integrating Private Sector resource and capabilities into the disaster response efforts across the CUSEC region in support of a national model.

**Session:** The agreed upon Advisory Group members will be seated at the front of the room. The audience will be made up of state directors and other interested private sector members from all elements.

**Specific facilitated Topics to be covered:**

- CAPSTONE Overview
  
- Information Sharing Models and Specific data types
  - Situation Awareness (internal and external)
  - Communications techniques
  
- Entry and Access Issues and Options (Who, Why, When, Where and How – what model might work best)
  
- Cross states and entry parameters (placarding standards and advancing or easing State access processing)
  
- Identification, Badging and Clearance for Personnel (Skilled and Unskilled)
  
- Mission Request and Mission Contracting Process
  
- Accepting and applying volunteer and corporate donations of labor, goods and services

Each session will attempt to define what right looks like in a series of function points for desired advancement. The follow on session will lock in specific deliverables for development and agreement.

The goal is to develop a baseline of capabilities to be agreed upon, develop and integrated into portions of the exercise in 2014. Those that have successful lessons learned can be put forward as regional solutions and potential national models.
