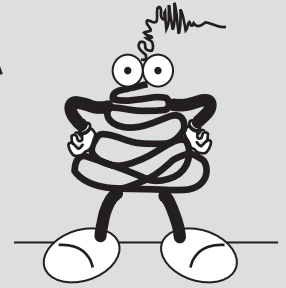


GET YOUR HOME READY FOR EARTHQUAKES!

On April 18, 2008, a magnitude 5.2 earthquake struck near Mt. Carmel, Illinois. This earthquake was felt in Missouri and at least 15 other states by over 40,000 people, according to the USGS.

Since January of 2008, there have been more than 300 earthquakes in the central United States. Some of these were felt over a large area of the region. When and where the next one will occur and how large it will be, are difficult, if not impossible, questions to answer with any certainty; however, reducing the vulnerability to damages is possible.

Even during smaller earthquakes, contents of your home can be susceptible to damage if not properly secured. By using sound, cost effective mitigation techniques, your losses can be reduced, and in some cases eliminated.
